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### **2023 NON-PROFIT BOOTH REQUEST**

**PLEASE NOTE:** Non-profit signage may not exceed more than 4 ft. from the lowest point of your tent canopy. Total of non-profit tent and signage may not exceed more than 12 ft. from the ground. Non-profit spaces will be assigned based on availability and suitability within the festival. While the SC Pecan Festival makes every effort to accommodate your space request, we cannot guarantee that you will receive any of the spaces requested. Non-profits are not allowed to distribute information/flyers/brochures/etc. outside of their 12' X 12' booth space. Fundraising and sales activities will not be allowed at non-profit spaces. If you wish to fundraise or sell items at your booth, a retail, food, or arts + crafts space will need to be purchased. Non-profit spaces WILL NOT be given access to electricity.

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Once your space has been assigned, you will receive and email confirmation with your space number. There are no fees associated with a non-profit space. Non-profit spaces are not eligible for access to electricity.

NON-PROFIT VENDOR SPACES WILL BE ASSIGNED <u>AFTER</u> SEPTEMBER 1, 2023, AND WILL BE LOCATED IN A DESIGNATED NON-PROFIT BOOTH VENDOR AREA.

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#### **NON-PROFIT VENDOR POLICIES**

PLEASE READ THE SC PECAN FESTIVAL NON-PROFIT VENDOR POLICIES CAREFULLY. BY SUBMITTED YOUR COMPLETED APPLICATION, YOU AGREE TO ABIDE BY ANY AND ALL POLICIES THAT MAY BE ESTABLISHED BY THE SC PECAN FESTIVAL COMMITTEE. VIOLATION OF ANY POLICIES BELOW MAY DISQUALIFY YOU FROM PARTICIPATING AT FUTURE EVENTS.

- The SC Pecan Festival Committee reserves the sole right to select any and all participants. In addition to the criteria listed below, applicants will be approved based on prior participation, product duplication, utility requirements, spirit of cooperation, and overall fit with the festival.
- Submission of an application and payment does not guarantee acceptance into the SC Pecan Music & Food Festival.
   Applications received after the August 31, 2023 deadline will only be considered if space is available.
- Applications will be processed in the order of date received and must include all attachments and other information
  that may be required in order for the application to be considered. An incomplete application will be removed from
  consideration.
- ALL NON-PROFIT VENDORS MUST SUBMIT A COPY OF THEIR IRS DETERMINATION LETTER AND PROOF OF VALID
  REGISTRATION WITH THE SC SECRETARY OF STATE. The SC Pecan Music & Food Festival offers a limited number of
  non-profit vendor spaces, free of charge, to qualifying organizations.
- Vendor set-up begins at 7:30 a.m. on Festival Day for all non-profit vendors. Vendors must keep their vehicles
  pulled close to their spaces for load-in and load-out. Do NOT leave your vehicle in the middle of the street during
  this time.
- All vendor vehicles must be moved off of the street no later than 9:00 a.m. on festival day and vendors must be ready to their spaces by 9:45 a.m. Driving through crowds is strictly not allowed.
- Vendors must remain open and visitor-ready until 7:00 p.m. Vendors are not allowed vehicular access onto the festival grounds until 8:00 p.m. Vendors are advised to bring dollies should they need to leave between 7:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. to transport goods to their vehicles. This also applies to vendors parked within festival ground lots.
- NON-PROFITS ARE LIMITED TO SOLICITATION ONLY WITHIN THEIR ASSIGNED VENDOR SPACES. Vendors may NOT
  extend solicitation (pass out flyers, information, books, etc.) outside of their designated space. Doing so will result in
  loss of space and vendors will not be invited to participate in future festivals.
- Non-profit vendors are not eligible for access to power.
- Non-profit spaces are 12 ft. X 12 ft. A 10X10 tent and one table will be provided to non-profit vendors. The SC Pecan Festival will NOT provide chairs or extra set-up materials. Non-profits are responsible for their own signage.
- Fundraising/sales are not allowed in the free non-profit occupied spaces. If fundraising/sales activities are to be conducted, an arts + crafts or retail space will need to be purchased at full price and no set-up materials will be provided.
- All giveaways or raffles must be approved in advance by the SC Pecan Festival Committee.
- The SC Pecan Music & Food Festival is not responsible for festival interruption due to weather or any cause beyond the control of the SC Pecan Festival committee.
- A vendor packet containing your space assignment, entry pass, festival map, and any special instructions for entry
  and exit will be mailed to you at the mailing address provided in this application within two weeks of the festival.
   Copies of entry documents can also be emailed to you, but will not include the entry pass.
- Vendors must initial and sign each space required in this application for submission to be considered complete.
   Incomplete applications will not be processed.
- Vendors are responsible for leaving the space in the same condition as when the vendor arrived.
- No amplified music or speakers are allowed at vendor booths.
- If a vendor is rude or disrespectful to the public, event staff, or other vendors, they will be asked to leave the festival, and the vendor is subject to disqualification from future events.
- Vendors or their authorized designee are responsible for signing in at vendor check-in the day of the festival.

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
